FY20 STATISTICS




WHO USES THE LIBRARY?

CIRCULATION




BORROWERS

UPDATED TECHNOLOGY

The library received a Gilbert & Barbara Renze Grant that enabled the library to have the local newspaper digitized - making it available to everyone - for use in the library or at home with a computer. The library also received an ARPA Grant and was able to purchase a new copy/scan/fax machine plus update a computer.
