
FY20 STATISTICS




WHO USES THE LIBRARY?


Over the past year we have seen 5,086 visitors to the library. Visitors use the library for many reasons, even when they cannot visit their home library, they are visiting our library!

FY20 ACHIEVEMENTS

Highlighting the top three achievements of the Wall Lake Public Library over the past year. We've been on a roll implementing new services and updating library spaces.



The library was a recipient of an LSTA Grant through the State Library of Iowa and received funds to update one new computer, a laptop, AWE Learning Station for children, Deep Freeze security software, Silhouette Cameo Electronic Cutter, a wireless printer, Zoom magnifier/reader software for computers and a Keys-u-see wireless keyboard.

2 ADULT READING AREA

An oak cabinet was added to the adult reading area and a keurig machine to be enjoyed by our customers at the library.

3 PROGRAMS

The library hosted 60 programs with 1,434 attendees, including preschool story time, book club, after school and holiday programs, craft and educational programs, maker camps, and after school movies, While the library was closed due to COVID-19, we had craft bags available for children during holiday and summer reading weeks and also for adults during National Library Week.

UPDATED WEBSITE
