1,219 USES OF ECTRONIC SOURCES 7,056 TOTAL CHECKOUTS





Over the past year we have seen 3,105 visitors to the library. Visitors use the library for many reasons, even when they cannot visit their home library, they are visiting our library!




BORROWERS
